Foxbridge Plate for I DO

WS will target their own feature race with the quality mare **I Do** early in the new racing season. The daughter of **No Excuse Needed** has been set for the **Gr.3 Foxbridge Plate**, which is sponsored by the farm, at Te Rapa on August 16.

The winner of three stakes races from her last six appearances, she will be served later in the year and may get the opportunity to also add a Group One victory to further boost her broodmare value.

"She's had a fortnight off and Mark (Chittick) and I have decided to have a go at the Foxbridge Plate and the Makfi if track conditions suit," said trainer Allan Sharrock, who races the mare with co-breeders WS.

I Do won the **Gr.3 Manawatu Challenge Stakes** before a summer break and added the **Rotorua Stakes** and the **Tauranga Classic**, both at **Listed** level, to her record in the autumn.

Sharrock said he was happy to leave breeding plans for **I Do** up to Chittick - *"I train them and he breeds them"* - but **Savabeel** looms as a favourite. Any resulting offspring would produce a three-quarter brother or sister to the recent **Listed Queensland Cup** winner **Iggi Pop**.

Tried and true tools of the trade

One of the excellent tools available on our website to enable you to conduct your own pedigree analysis is a **TrueNicks** link for each of our stallions. This lets you to get a quantified assessment of the results to date when mares by a given sire or sire line have been mated with the sire in question, or their sire line. This is a simple way to gain a valuable assessment. But you need to know how to use it, because what tends to happen is that it sometimes highlights small pockets of data that show very successful results to date based on smaller sample sizes. So, that needs to be factored into your interpretation of the results – it is not necessarily the case that you would automatically assess an A++ result as being “better” than a B result – because of the sample sizes.

Anyway, for interest sake, I thought I would review a few of the higher results that breeders have seen when they have assessed matings over the past month – as an insight into the type of data that is produced. An example of an **A++** result generated against each of our stallions in the past month is as follows:



- **O'Reilly** – When mated with mares by **Zabeel** and his sons and grandsons – **25** runners, **5** stakes winners, **20%** SW/Rnrs – **Silent Achiever, O'Marilyn** etc
- **Savabeel** – When mated with mares by **Last Tycoon** and his sons and grandsons – **36** runners, **6** stakes winners, **16.7%** SW/Rnrs – **Costume, Chintz, Diademe** etc
- **Ocean Park** – When **Thorn Park** and his sons have been mated with **Danske** mares – **7** runners, **2** stakes winners, **28.6%** SW/Rnrs – **Sacred Park and Magic Briar**
- **Pins** – When mated with **Carnegie** mares – **8** runners, **2** stakes winners, **25%** SW/Rnrs – **Antonio Lombardo and Bespoke**
- **Rock N Pop** – When **Fastnet Rock** and his sons have been mated with mares by **Storm Bird** and his sons and grandsons – **39** runners, **6** stakes winners, **15.4%** SW/Rnrs - **Foxwedge, Irish Lights, Zululand** etc
- **No Excuse Needed** – When mated with mares by **Blushing Groom** and his sons and grandsons – **12** runners, **2** stakes winners, **16.7%** SW/Rnrs – **Vincent Mangano and Lesley Brook**
- **Rios** – When **Hussonet** and his sons have been mated with mares by **Snippets** and his sons and grandsons – **10** runners, **4** stakes winners, **40%** SW/Rnrs – **Husson Lightning, Rio Carnival** etc

So, you can see the type of data that is generated by these **TrueNicks** queries. Please feel welcome to go on our website and generate your own queries for your mare against any of our stallions.
